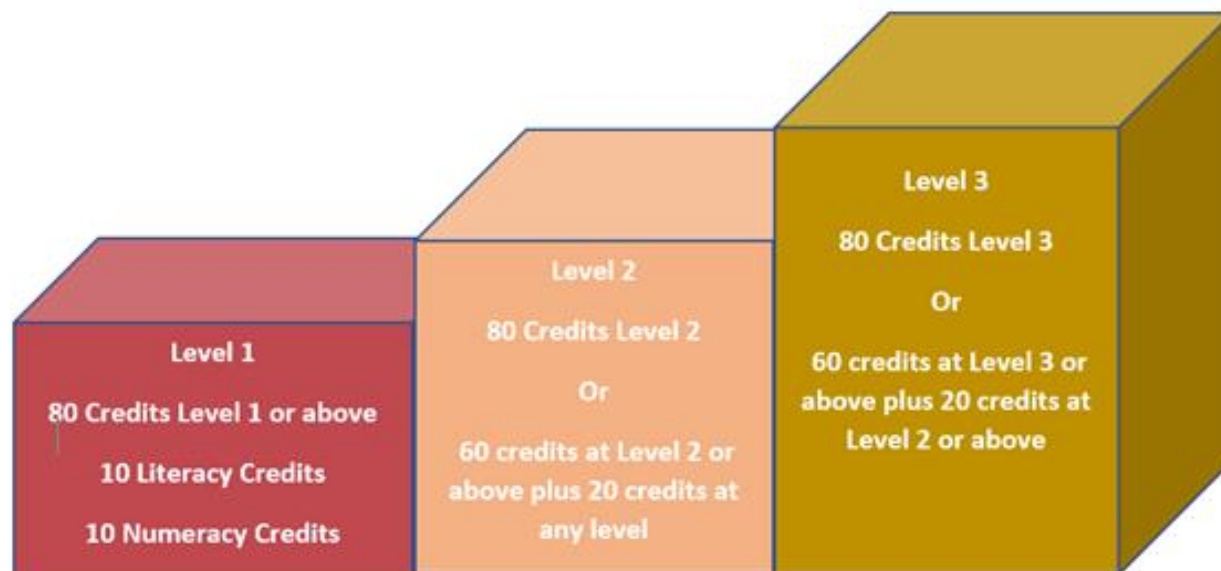

What are Achievement Standards?

- A subject is divided into 5-6 topics or ACHIEVEMENT STANDARDS
- A standard measures what you can do eg “solve right angled triangle problems”, “describe atomic structure and bonding”
- Each achievement standard is worth a number of points or CREDITS

How are Achievement Standards Assessed?

- Internally – in class during the year
- These standards are called internal assessments
- Externally – in exams at the end of the year
- These standards are called external assessments

What are the possible grades for an Achievement Standard ?

- N Not Achieved
 - A Achievement
 - M Merit
 - E Excellence

- A, M or E results in the same number of credits
 - You do not get more credits if your grade is higher

- **MUST** include at least 3 internal credits and 3 external credits in ONE subject and ONE year

Merit

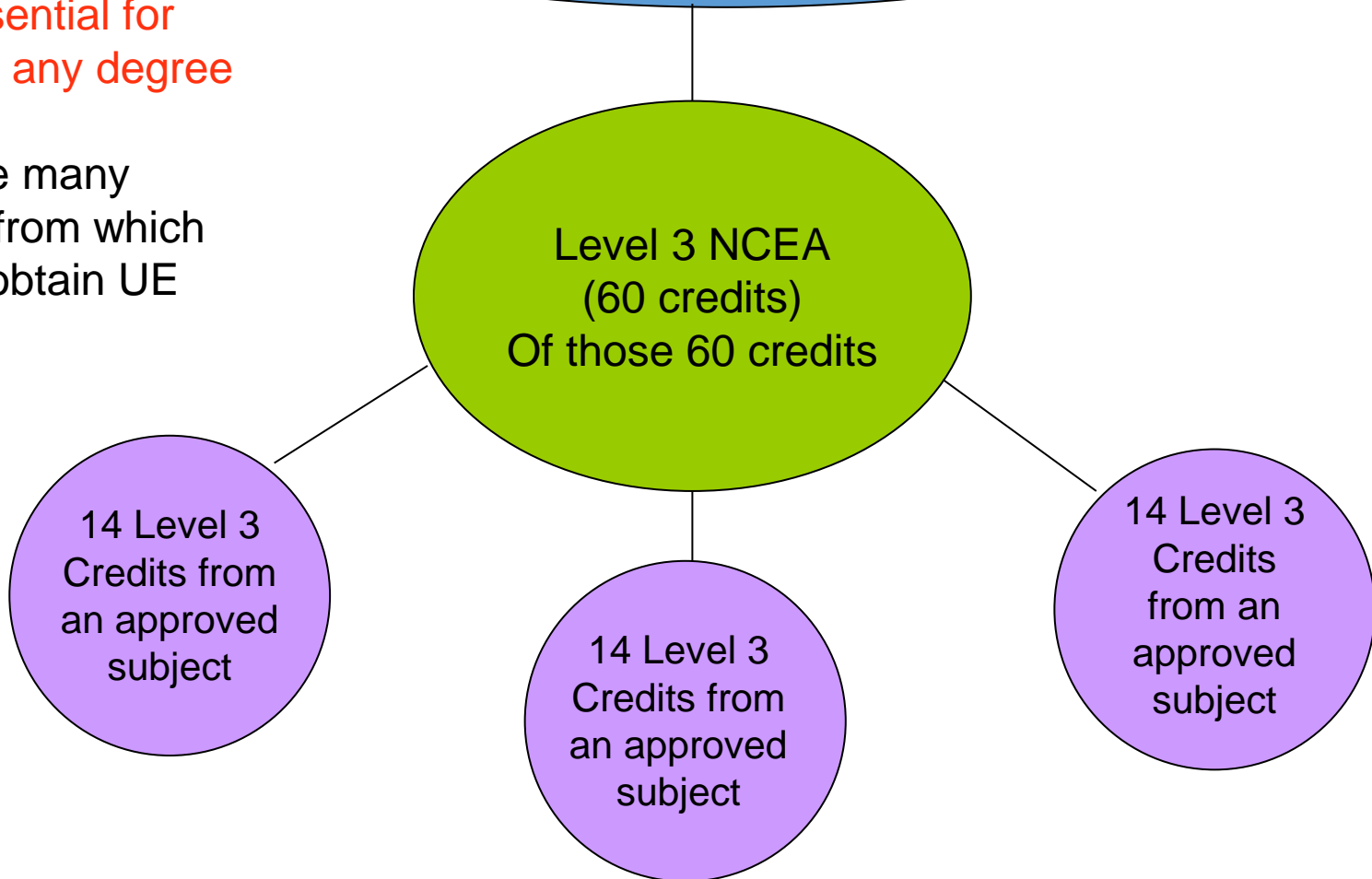
- **Course Endorsed with Merit**
- 14+ credits at Merit or Excellence
- **MUST** include at least 3 internal credits and 3 external credits in ONE subject and ONE year

University Entrance Criteria

UE Numeracy -10 credits at Level 1 or above
UE Literacy – 10 credits (5 credits in reading and 5 credits in writing from Level 2 or above)

UE is essential for entry into any degree course.

There are many subjects from which you can obtain UE Literacy.
