FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. Who is TaxGift?

TaxGift Limited is a New Zealand registered company and is registered as a tax agent with the NZ IRD. TaxGift Limited is a member of the Fundraising Institute of New Zealand (FINZ) and is bound by its code of ethics and code of conduct. TaxGift has partnered with more than 60 New Zealand schools and charities. More information about TaxGift and the service it provides can be found on its website. https://www.taxgift.co.nz/

2. How is TaxGift Paid?

Baradene College Limited (BCL) pays TaxGift a small fee for its services. No money leaves your bank account.

3. How does signing up to TaxGift affect my other tax arrangements?

Signing up to TaxGift appoints TaxGift as your tax agent solely for the purpose of gifting the tax credits on your BCL Donation Receipts back to BCL. It does not affect any other tax agents that you might have (for example, if you have an accountant who does your tax returns).

4. Is everyone eligible to sign up to TaxGift?

You must be an individual and a New Zealand tax resident who has earned taxable income in the relevant tax year to be eligible for the tax credit.

5. Can I opt out of TaxGift?

You can opt out of TaxGift at any time by emailing admin@taxgift.co.nz.

6. What happens to my personal information?

By signing up to TaxGift you will be providing TaxGift with personal information (your name, contact information and IRD number) to enable TaxGift to offer its services to you and/or BCL.
