

OUR FOUR FUNDS

The Baradene College Foundation, known as Growing Heart, has four funds which support the College to grow and develop in line with its strategic goals.

STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP AND SUPPORT FUND

The Student Scholarship and Support Fund is used to offer students from diverse backgrounds the opportunity to secure a Baradene education, to support current students who would otherwise be prevented from completing their education or are unable to fully participate in College life, and to provide additional learning opportunities to students enabling them to pursue their potential.

In 2022, the first Growing Heart Scholarship was awarded to a deserving student which will be truly life-changing for this student and her family.

We hope many more Growing Heart scholarships will be awarded in the future.

STAFF SUPPORT FUND

Attracting and retaining inspirational teachers is essential for high-achieving schools.

The Staff Support Fund is used to foster teaching excellence by supporting teachers with professional development and other career opportunities.

COLLEGE FACILITIES FUND

The College Facilities Fund is used to support the fit out of specific school building projects and for resources to ensure the College has the facilities required to deliver the best education possible.

TRUSTEES DISCRETIONARY

The Growing Heart Trustees want to ensure Baradene maintains its special character and qualities. The Trustees Discretionary Fund allows the Trustees to determine the most important areas of need within the College.
