

## 2026 SQUASH

**TOURNAMENTS:** Wednesday 13 May, 24 June & 5 August  
Individual Championships 5<sup>th</sup> – 7<sup>th</sup> May (for graded players only)

**ELIGIBILITY:** Years 9 – 13

**VENUE:** Games will be at various venues around Auckland

**TRANSPORT:** We require parental assistance with transport to and from tournaments.

**UNIFORM:** All players will be issued with a Baradene singlet, which they will assume responsibility for during the tournaments. Any damage or failure to return at the end of the tournaments will result in a charge being issued.  
These singlets are to be worn with PE shorts and non marking, clean shoes only.  
Girls are to travel to and from events in the School Tracksuit wearing sport shoes only.

**EQUIPMENT:** It is compulsory for all players to wear safety glasses while playing. These can be purchased from the Sports Department for \$20 upon request once registrations have been taken.  
Girls are to use their own racquets, however if they do not have one this can also be issued by the Sports Department upon request. Any damage or failure to return this at the end of the season will result in a charge being issued.

**COST:** \$130

There may be additional cost for tournaments

This is required to be paid in full prior to each tournament. You will be advised once the fee is loaded on the portal for payment.

**TRAININGS:** Thursday mornings at Remuera Rackets Club (7.00am-8.00am) starting Term 2.  
Transport assistance will be required following trainings to get players to Baradene.

*Please note:*

*Withdrawing from a team once named is not acceptable at Baradene. If this occurs your daughter will not be permitted to represent Baradene in any other code for the season, so please ensure all commitments are considered prior to committing to teams.*
