- SEASON:** 1st XI – Term 4 (Wednesday 21st October – Wednesday 25th November)
Year 7/8A – Term 4 (Monday afternoons)
Year 7/8A Skill Sessions - Term 4 (Monday mornings)
- ELIGIBILITY:** Years 7 – 13
(Year 7/8 are only permitted to play Senior grade if there are not enough players and can compete at that level)
- GAMES:** 1st XI - Wednesday's afterschool (may have some Monday games depending on entries)
Y7/8 – Monday afternoons
- VENUE:** Games will be at various venues around Auckland
- TRANSPORT:** We require parental assistance with transport across the season and it is expected that families assist on a roster system where required.
- UNIFORM:** The 1st XI will be issued a Baradene Cricket Top & Pants, which they will assume responsibility for the Term. Any damage or failure to return at the end of the term will result in a charge being issued.
Year 7/8 wear the Baradene PE top & Tracksuit Pants.
All players are to travel to and from events in the School Tracksuit wearing sport shoes only.
