

2026 JUNIOR VOLLEYBALL

For students wishing to trial for our junior volleyball teams, and play in the College Sport competition, see trial dates below. We can only accommodate 30 students for the College Sport competition, as we are limited to entering 3 teams into this competition. If numbers exceed 30, we will look at an intraschool competition run over a 4-week period (day TBC). This competition will depend on numbers registered.

AGE ELIGIBILITY: Years 9 & 10

SEASON: 15th October – 12th November 2026

GAMES & VENUES: Teams will play 2 games each night as well as a duty round. Games will be played from 4pm to approximately 6pm at various Auckland venues.

TRAINING: Trainings will be determined by the team coach once selections are made. These can be before school or after school.

UNIFORM: A Baradene sports top will be issued for the season, which they will assume responsibility for during the season. Any damage or failure to return at the end of the season will result in a charge being issued. Players will also be required to wear plain black shorts or black spunks. They are to travel to and from events in the School Tracksuit wearing sport shoes only.

TRANSPORT:

Parents will be required to transport their daughters to games and tournaments. A school van would be available if required and it is expected that families assist on a roster system where required. If the vans are unavailable, we may arrange for a bus when necessary.

Please note: Withdrawing from a team once named is not acceptable at Baradene. If this occurs your daughter will not be permitted to represent Baradene in any other code for the season, so please ensure all commitments are considered prior to committing to trials.
